

"My Language Art Contest" – Modern Greek

Open to: Kindergarten to Year 6

Submission date: June 15th Term 2.

Requirements:

Individual art contest open to all languages. Each entry must include the two focus phrases:

I am (name). I like (language being studied e.g., Italian). So, in Modern Greek it would be:

Με λένε _____ (student's name). Μ'αρέσουν τα Ελληνικά.

Students are to submit a piece of art that represents the culture they are learning about in their language

lessons.

There are no restrictions regarding the size and format of the artwork. Artworks could include a collage, digital art, drawing/painting/ 3D collage, diorama, craft project undertaken in class. *The only requirement is to include the 2 focus phrases somewhere on the artwork. These phrases must be written in language being studied.*

This contest is open to all primary languages including Indonesian, Modern Greek, Italian, Japanese.

Submission method: Submission will be by digital photograph of the artwork uploaded to a Google Drive.

Prizes: There are two types of prizes being awarded in 2023 – **Language specific** and **Stage specific**.

Language specific prizes are awarded within one language e.g., Japanese but across all ages e.g., K-6.

Stage specific prizes are awarded within one Stage e.g., Stage 3 but across all languages.

There will also be **a separate prize** for non-2D artworks e.g., models, masks, sculptures, dolls, toys etc.

The prizes are showbags of culturally relevant items.

A **Language specific prize winner** receives only items from that culture eg all Modern Greek products.

A **Stage specific prize winner** receives items from across the 4 languages with a note explaining which culture the item relates to.

Certificates for all prize winners and participants will be awarded.
